TESTING

Our trained professionals identify and measure hearing loss and perform a hearing test to assess the type and degree of loss.

Comprehensive Audiograms: pure tone, speech recognition, air and bone conduction, Evoked Otoacoustic Emissions, Tympanograms and Eustachian tube dysfunction testing available.
